Prostitutes: Do you belong?

1 Samuel 16:7 New Living Translation

But the LORD said to Samuel, "Don't judge by his appearance or height, for I have rejected him. The LORD doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart."

- Tamar -
- Rahab - Not an Israelite. A Canaanite prostitute living among the enemies of God. Mother of a Godly son.
- Ruth - Not an Israelite. A Moabite. Widowed. Essentially homeless and begging for food. Mother to the grandfather of David
- Bathsheba - A victim of a powerful king. Unfaithful to her husband. Mother to the wisest king who ever was.
- Mary - A young, unassuming virgin, committed to be married. Mother to the Messiah

Genesis 37:3-4 New Living Translation

Jacob loved Joseph more than any of his other children because Joseph had been born to him in his old age. So one day Jacob had a special gift made for Joseph—a beautiful robe. But his brothers hated Joseph because their father loved him more than the rest of them. They couldn't say a kind word to him.

Judah marries a Canaanite woman and has 3 sons. (Genesis 38:1-5)

- His sons were named: Er, Onan & Shelah

But as they were taking her out to kill her, she sent this message to her father-in-law: "The man who owns these things made me pregnant. Look closely. Whose seal and cord and walking stick are these?"

Abraham was the father of Isaac.

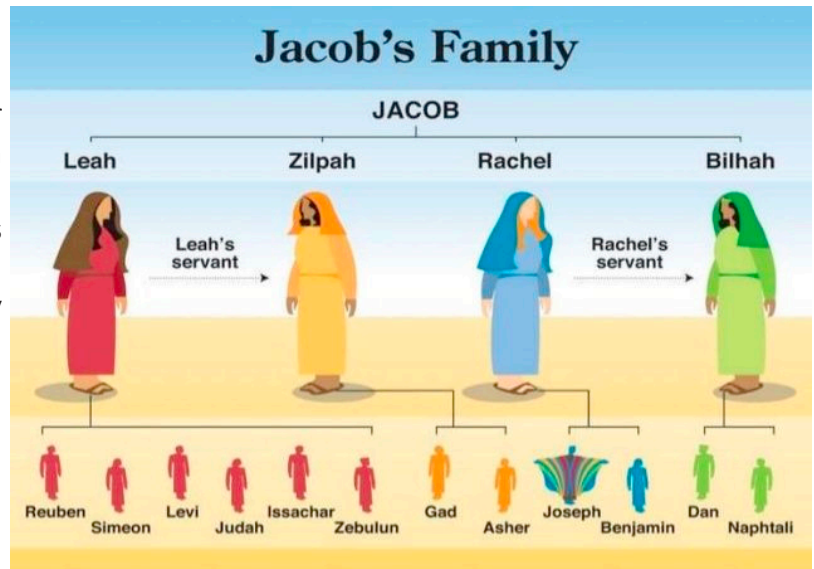
Isaac was the father of Jacob.
