

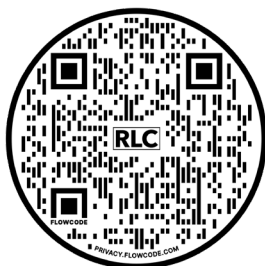

IN THE BEGINNING

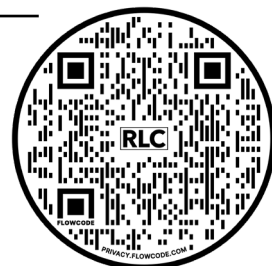
