

SUPERBOWL PARTY





DISCOVERYO

Exodus 19:3-6 New International Version

Then Moses went up to God, and the LORD called to him from the mountain and said, "This is what you are to say to the descendants of Jacob and what you are to tell the people of Israel: 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites."

For further study on your own:

God brought the Israelites to the desert to be with them. Exodus 29:45-46 NIV

45 Then I will dwell among the Israelites and be their God. 46 They will know that I am the LORD their God, who brought them out of Egypt so that I might dwell among them. I am the LORD their God. Scan through Exodus and Deuteronomy to find all the ways God was with or among his people in the desert.

God takes a suitable helper for Himself.

Many people recognize Mount Sinai as the location where God gave the ten commandments to Moses, but most, even among those who call themselves Christians, fail to recognize the significance of what took place between God and his people there. To some, the Ten Commandments are merely a list of Gods dos and don'ts. Few realize that the Ten Commandments are a brief summary of the formative, life-changing covenant God established with his people at Mount Sinai.

That covenant defined and affirmer God's relationship with Israel. Similar to the way God gave Eve to be Adam's suitable helper in caring for creation, God claimed Israel to be his suitable helper in the mission of redemption. Although the text does not specifically label God's revelation of the covenant on Mount Sinai as a wedding, the language and customs of marriage in ancient times appear throughout the story. The marriage language used highlights the love and intimacy God desired in his relationship with Israel. The image conveyed is that at Mount Sinai the Lord too Israel to be his bride!

- In English a Kingdom = The geography or physical territory where a king reigns.
- In Hebrew Kingdom = Not just geography. It's everywhere the king is obeyed. Where His will is being
 done.

1 Peter 2:9-12 New International Version

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

Numbers 15:37-40 New International Version

The LORD said to Moses, "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: 'Throughout the generations to come you are to make tassels on the corners of your garments, with a blue cord on each tassel. You will have these tassels to look at and so you will remember all the commands of the LORD, that you may obey them and not prostitute yourselves by chasing after the lusts of your own hearts and eyes. Then you will remember to obey all my commands and will be consecrated to your God.

Home Group Notes

Pray: It is always good by having someone begin group with prayer and invite the Spirit to join in on your group. (It may help to ask someone else ahead of time, some people like to prepare.)

Intro: Leaders ask the question below and give the group a moment to think about it, then go in a circle ans share your answers.

• If you were a King or Queen of a kingdom, what would your kingdom look like? What would some of your laws or rules be? Who would be honored or praised? What actions or responsibilities would be rewarded? What would the goals or priorities be? How would you treat the citizens of your kingdom? (Artistic people: what would your flag look like?)

Questions: These questions are merely meant as a discussion tool. If it sparks a fruitful conversation, let it carry on. By no means feel bound to answer everything or stick only to these questions. Read them ahead of time and let the Spirit guide you how to use them for your group.

- Review the sermon notes, what is the difference between the modern english understanding of "kingdom" and the Hebrew understanding? Which version makes more sense to you? Why?
- God is working to establish His kingdom on earth through the Israelites, why do you think God wants to work through people rather than just using His unlimited power to force His kingdom here?
- How does God treat the citizens of His kingdom? What does His kingdom look like?
- Would you say you are apart of God's kingdom? What is your role? How can we help God spread His kingdom here on earth?

Pray Again: You can never pray too much, but this is a good time to ask if there are anything the group can be praying for. Leaders, be sure to take some notes and pray for your groups throughout
