

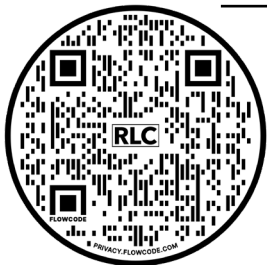
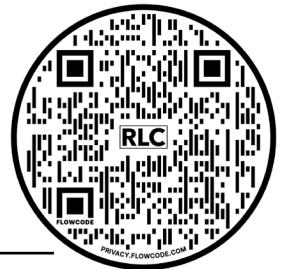

IN THE BEGINNING

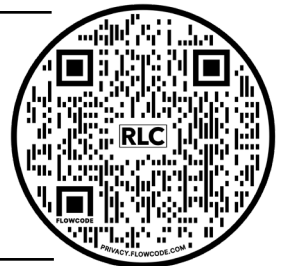

Do you believe Jesus did what He did because He loves you?

Ephesians 5:2 New Living Translation

"No one takes my life from me. I lay it down on my own, in my own time, when I choose. I give my love freely to you. No one forced me to do what I did for you. I did it because I love you."

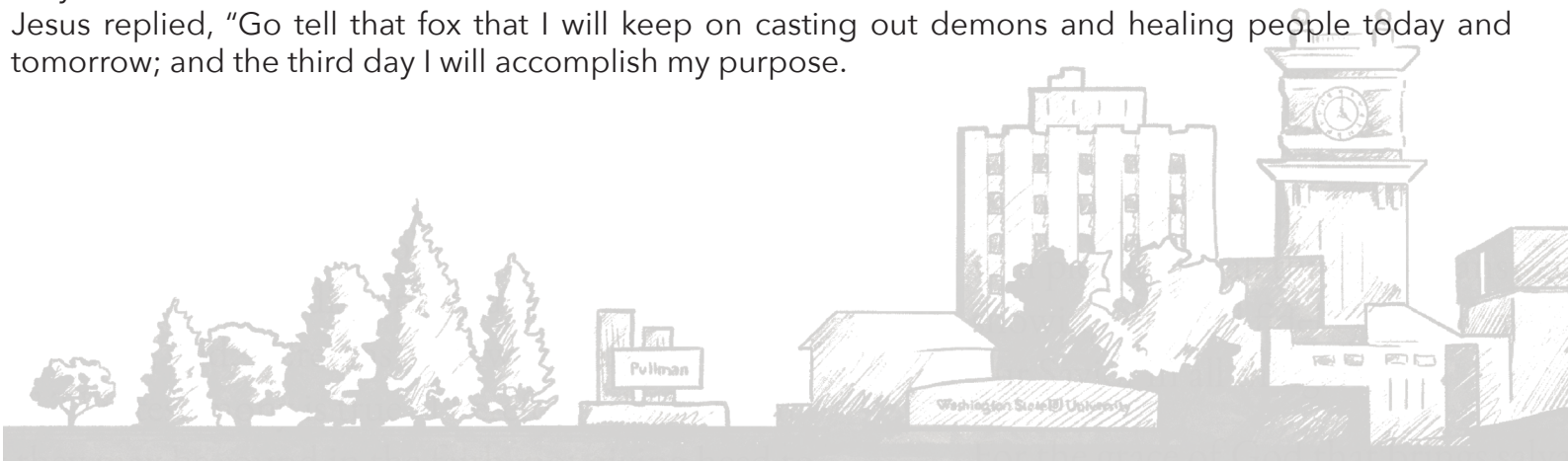
Luke 4:28-30 New Living Translation

“Put away your sword,” Jesus told him. “Those who use the sword will die by the sword. Don’t you realize that I could ask my Father for thousands of angels to protect us, and he would send them instantly?”

But if you refuse to serve the LORD, then choose today whom you will serve. Would you prefer the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates? Home Group Notes

Pray: It is always good by having someone begin group with prayer and invite the Spirit to join in on your group. (It may help to ask someone else ahead of time, some people like to prepare.)

Intro: How have you seen God moving in your life recently?

Questions: Read these out and discuss as a group, if you have more thinkers than talkers, maybe give them a moment to write out their thoughts on some of them. As always these are a tool to help build relationships with each other and grow closer to God, use them until they aren't useful.

- Let's write out a couple of lists. Who can you say confidently loves you unconditionally? Who do you think you love unconditionally?
- How do those relationships show that love? How do you express your love for others?
- Do you truly believe Jesus loves you? Have you ever doubted it? Why or why not?
- How does knowing Jesus loves you change your life? The decisions you make? Your character?
- Do you love Jesus? If yes, why and how do you express that love?

Pray Again: You can never pray too much, but this is a good time to ask if there are anything the group can be praying for. Leaders, be sure to take some notes and pray for your groups throughout
